

# CRAFT KITS FROM THE PROVIDENCE ATHENÆUM'S CHILDREN'S LIBRARY

## SUN-A-RONI!

*This suncatcher is a fun, unique way to use pasta and glue!*

### Supplies in kit

- 1 bag of colored pasta
- 1 piece of string

### What you'll need from home

- a shallow plastic lid from a food container
- liquid school glue
- patience!



### Directions

1. Fill the upturned lid with enough liquid glue to cover the whole surface and set the pasta in place when it's dried (but don't go over the top).



2. Arrange the pasta all around on the glue. You can try patterns, or freestyle. Anything goes!



3. Place your sun catcher in a safe place. Using your patience, leave it to dry for 1 to 2 days, until the glue is completely dry and clear. Then gently pry the glue disc away from the cover.



4. Have an adult help you poke a hole on the edge and attach the string. Hang your colorful sun catcher in a sunny window and voila! It's a beautiful sun-a-roni suncatcher!
