Supplies

- Colored dry pasta noodles
- String with a masking tape “needle”

Directions

Using the masking tape “needle,” thread colored noodles onto your string. Hint: tie a large piece to the other end first to prevent noodles from slipping off! Play with patterns and colors, and tie together your creation and wear with pride!
