# TREASURE POUCHES!

*Everyone needs a secret hiding place for their treasures! Make this felt pouch to keep coins, found objects, and all kinds of things.*

## Supplies in kit

- felt circle
- yarn
- pasta beads

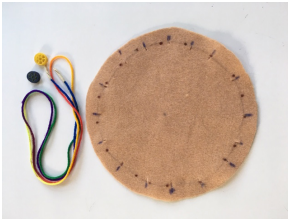
## What you'll need from home

- scissors



## Directions

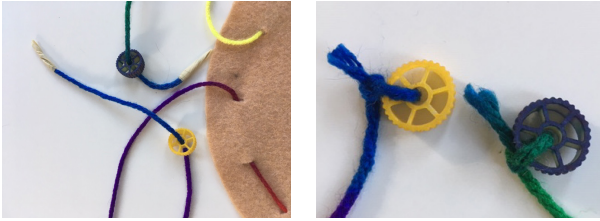
1. The felt disc has markings where small slits are cut for threading the drawstring. Flip the disc over so that the markings will be on the inside of the pouch.



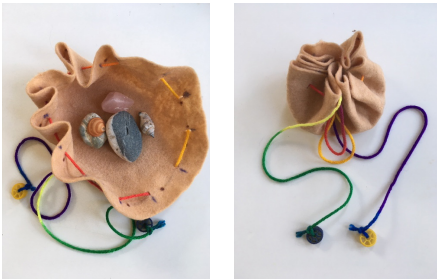
2. Begin threading the drawstring from the unmarked side to the marked side then up through the next slit and continue until both ends of the drawstring are on the same side of the disc.



1. Thread the pasta beads on to the ends of the drawstring, then tie them off and snip off the taped ends with scissors.



2. Gently pull the drawstring to start gathering the sides of the disc to form the bowl where your treasures will be stored. Pull the drawstring until the pouch is closed and voila, your treasures are safe and sound!
