## Supplies in kit

- 1 paper towel tube
- black crepe paper
- orange crepe paper
- brown construction paper
- black construction paper
- white construction paper
- 1 green pipe cleaner
- googly eyes

## What you'll need from home

- scissors
- glue stick
- stapler
- tiny pebbles or dried beans



## Directions

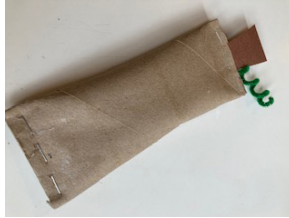
1. Cut out a pumpkin stem shape. Holding the stem in place inside the end of the tube, staple the top together.



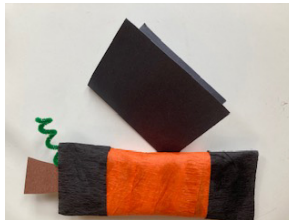
2. Curl the pipe cleaner around a pencil to make a "vine" and insert it in the top, next to the stem.



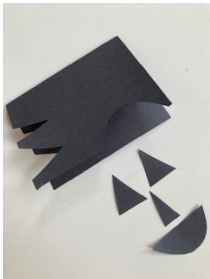
3. Turn the tube upside-down and drop in the pebbles into the open end. Staple the end closed.



4. Coat the outside of the noisemakers with glue and wrap it with orange crepe paper. Glue and wrap black construction paper detail (optional).



5. Cut out the pumpkin silly or scary eyes, nose, and mouth, and glue. Add some googly eyes with glue and make some noise!
