# ARCTIC FOX PUPPET!

*Arctic foxes have fluffy white fur in the winter so that they can easily hide in the snow!*

## Supplies in kit

- 1 paper plate cut in half
- pre-cut Arctic fox pieces
- googly eyes
- pre-cut white tissue
- 1 craft stick



## What you'll need from home

- stapler (optional)
- glue stick or school glue
- tape

## Directions

1. Make a fold toward the middle of one of the half-circles. Fold over the other half and glue down.

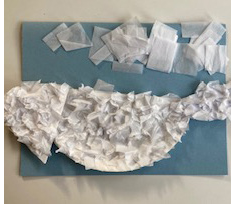


2. Glue this triangle piece to the other half-circle to become the head and the body.



3. Staple or glue on the tail, then scrunch the little tissue pieces and glue them to the fox's head and body. Now your fox has

plenty of nice warm fur!



4. It's time to add the finishing touches! Glue on the legs, ears, eyes and nose!



5. Tape the craft stick to the back of the fox. Now your fluffy little fox is ready for a game of hide and seek across the tundra!
