# A HOUSE FOR A LEPRECHAUN!

*Even leprechauns need a home  
to curl up in after a long day of

## Supplies in kit

- house form
- roof
- yellow “shingles”
- roof topper leaves
- door and windows
- decorative stickers
- a leprechaun



## What you'll need from home

- glue stick or school glue
- scissors
- colored markers or crayons
- glitter (optional)

## Directions

1. Glue shingles to the roof.



2. Glue the leaf detail to cover the top, snip between the leaves and gently press them down, and add a decorative sticker.



3. Cut along the solid line to create a door for the house. Glue on the door and windows. This is a good time to add your own details, stickers, or glitter.



4. Add glue along one end of the house and bring the ends together.



5. Pop on the roof, and it's "move-in day!"
