Supplies in kit

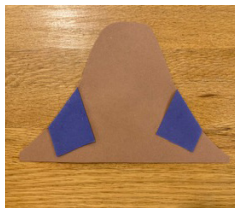
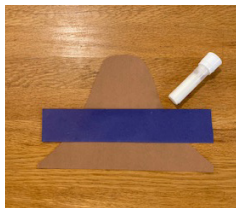
- 1 pre-cut hat
- 1 paper plate
- 1 hat band
- 1 pre-cut bandana
- 1 pre-cut coffee filter (3 pieces)
- 2 eyes and a nose
- 1 autumn leaf

What you'll need from home

- scissors
- glue stick or school glue
- color markers, pencils, or crayons

Directions

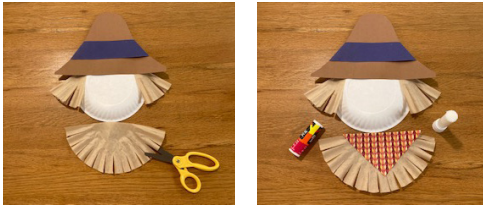
1. Glue the hat band on the hat. Turn it over, fold the ends, and glue them to the back of the hat.



2. Take the two small, folded pieces of coffee filter, snip the edges into a fringe, and glue them to the paper plate. Glue the hat to the paper plate over the "hair."



3. Snip the edges of the larger piece of coffee filter and glue the “bandana” to it.



4. Turn the paper plate over and glue the coffee filter to the lower part of the back of the paper plate.



5. Turn the paper plate over to the front. Add the eyes and nose and draw on the mouth. Add the leaf to the hat band and you have one dandy scarecrow!
