FANCIFUL FAN!

Make this super simple fanciful fan, and you will be cool in more ways than one!

Supplies in kit

- 1 pre-cut two-sided fan
- selection of mixed color tissue squares
- 1 large craft stick



What you'll need from home

- glue stick or school glue and tape
- optional: markers, crayons, or color pencils

Directions

1. Think about how you want to decorate your fan. Pictured above are two different styles of tissue collage: the left is mostly made with cut tissue and the right is mostly torn tissue. Anything goes! Tear or cut, layer your colors, or add details with markers. Feel free to use your own materials from home like ribbon or even pictures - whatever suits your fancy!



2. When you have decorated your fan, flip it over, fold up any ragged edges, and glue them to the back of the fan. Next add the craft stick to the inside center of the fan template. Add glue to the edges and then fold over the other flap pressing down the edges so that it stays together!



3. Now you can see both sides of your fanciful fan when you hold it up! Stay cool!
