BOOKWORM BOOKMARK!

This colorful striped bookworm is a stylish way to keep track of where you left off in your favorite book!



Supplies in kit

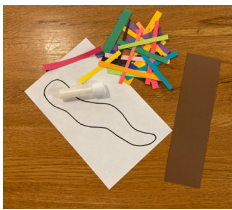
- pre-cut colored paper strips
- bookworm template
- pre-cut bookmark
- 2 white stickers
- 2 black stickers
- 1 string

What you'll need from home

- glue stick or school glue
- hole punch
- scissors
- a marker

Directions

1. Add your colored strips of paper to the bookworm template. Leave a little bit of space between the strips (so you can still see the bookworm's outline). Then cut the bookworm out.



2. Glue the bookworm to the bookmark strip, then add the eyes and a friendly smile.



- Using a hole puncher, make a hole at the head of the bookmark and thread the string through the hole.



- Hurry to your favorite library, borrow a huge stack of books, and put your new bookworm bookmark to work!
