PEEPERS THE PUMPKIN!

Peepers the Pumpkin is eager to see all of the wonderful Halloween costumes this Halloween. You can help by decorating his shell and adding some bright pumpkin eyes!

Supplies in kit

- 1 pumpkin template
- 1 yellow strip of paper
- 2 large with dot stickers
- 2 medium black dot stickers

What you'll need from home

- scissors
- markers
- glue stick or liquid school glue

Directions

 Color the pumpkin body, and lift the eyelids to color the underside.





2. Slide the yellow strip of paper under the eyes as pictured, and place a dot where you will place your stickers. Then snip the eyelids to make lashes.





3. Slide the paper strip out, and add the stickers over the dots.



4. Open the pumpkin template, add glue along the bottom of the paper, and close the template. This will help keep it secure when you are pushing and pulling the paper strip.



5. Cut out your design for the nose and mouth of the pumpkin to make a funny or scary face! When you have glued the features to Peeper's shell, you can now move the paper strip to create different expressions!
