Even if it doesn't snow outside, we will have this snowy scene inside to celebrate the winter season!

Supplies in kit

- 1 paper plate
- 1 pre-cut blue night sky
- 1 coloring template with
 houses, trees, snowperson, and moon
- gold star stickers
- fiber fill "snow"

What you'll need from home

- markers, crayons, or color pencils
- scissors
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- glitter (optional)


## Directions

1. Color the items on the template and cut them out. Be careful not to cut off the tabs!

2. Glue the night sky to the back of the paper plate at the fold as pictured.

3. Fold back the tabs on the cut-out figures as pictured. The folded tabs will be used to attach the houses trees and snowperson where you want them to be in the scene. Glue them to the plate. Glue the moon and stars to the sky, and finally tuck the snow around the trees and houses.

Optional: Adding touches of glitter really makes the scene sparkle!
