A HARVEST GNOME!

Supplies in kit

- 1 half paper towel tube
- pre-cut elements to build your gnome

What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue

Directions

1. Begin by gluing the gnome's beard and hat to the body, followed by the nose, the pumpkin, the hands, and feet as pictured.



2. Use glue to attach the gnome to the paper towel tube. Make sure to line the bottom of the gnome with the bottom of the tube because the tube provides the structure to hold the little gnome up. This autumnal little friend is now ready to add to your harvest decorations!
