# POPPY THE POP-UP TURKEY!

*Gobble gobble! Help Poppy stand to attention and maybe even invite her to be the centerpiece of your Thanksgiving table.*



### Supplies in kit

- 1 pre-cut paper plate
- 7 pre-cut turkey feathers
- 1 turkey torso
- 1 beak
- 2 each white and black dot stickers
- 1 wattle

### What you'll need from home

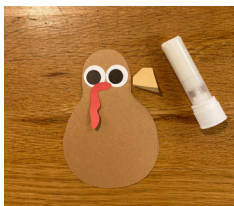
- colored markers, pencils, crayons, or paints
- glue stick or liquid school glue

### Directions

1. Begin by decorating the rim of the paper plate. I kept my decoration simple by using markers, but you can make yours as fancy as you like by using other materials!



2. Next, glue the eyes, wattle, and beak to the turkey's torso as pictured.



- Now it is time to glue the turkey's torso to the pre-cut flap of the decorated paper plate. Line up the torso to cover the flap, and gently crease the bottom of the torso. When it is glued to the flap, you can push the flap forward so that Poppy stands up.



- Finally, turn the paper plate around and glue the feathers to the back side of the flap in a fan pattern. Poppy is now ready to add her fancy feathers to your holiday table!
