WOVEN YARN BASKET!

Here's a cozy little project for a long winter day. Make this colorful little yarn basket to keep your treasures in!



Supplies in kit

- 1 pre-cut paper cup
- 1 small roll of yarn

What you'll need from home

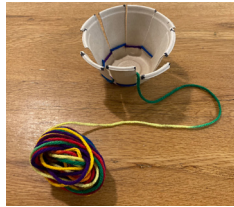
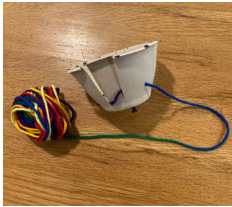
- sticky tape

Directions

1. Slip the end of the yarn between a slit in the bowl, and tape it to the bottom of the bowl as pictured.



2. Weave the yarn out through the next slit then continue to loop the yarn back and forth between the slits.



3. As you weave, gently push the "stitches" down with your finger to keep them pressed together.



4. When you have reached the top of the bowl, trim the end a little if needed, then gently tuck it behind the top “stitches” on the inside of the bowl as pictured.
