# DANCING DRAGON!

*The dragon parade is one of the highlights of the Chinese New Year. Make your own dragon!*

## Supplies in kit

- 1 dancing dragon template
- 7 colored paper strips
- 2 craft sticks



## What you'll need from home

- crayons, colored pencils, or markers
- glue stick
- sticky tape
- scissors

## Directions

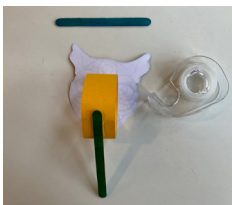
1. Begin by coloring the head, tail, and feet of the dragon.



2. Select a paper strip, and glue the ends together to create a circle. Then cut out the dragon's head and glue it to the circle.



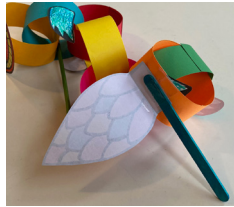
3. Tape one of the craft sticks to the other side of the circle.



- Using the circle attached to the dragon head as the start, use the rest of the paper strips to make a chain. Glue the dragon feet to the links as pictured.



- Glue the tail to the last link, then tape the second craft stick to the tail. Your dragon is ready to dance!
