# PIGGIE THE BANK!

## Supplies in kit

- 1 piggie face
- 1 pipe cleaner
- 1 flat paper box form
- 1 nose
- 2 black dot stickers

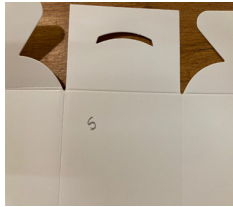
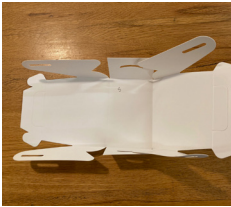


## What you'll need from home

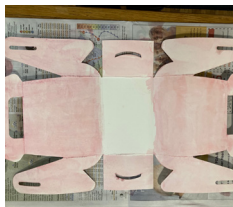
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- color markers, pencils, paint, or crayons
- optional: materials to decorate your box such as stickers, collage paper, etc.
- scissors

## Directions

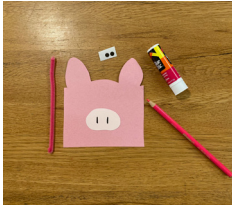
1. Fold and unfold the box at the creases so that it will be flexible when you are ready to put it together. Please note the letter "S" penciled on one side. When it is time to decorate your piggy box, turn it over and decorate the other side. The "S" should be on the inside of the bank when assembled.



2. It's time to decorate the box! You can use any materials you have on hand, such as watercolors, crayons, or tissue paper.



- Now this Piggy needs a face! Add the nose and eyes along with a smile and any other details you like. You can gently curl the ears around a pencil to add a fun dimension!



- Using scissors, poke a very small hole on one side of the box. Wrap the pipe cleaner around a pencil to make it curly, then slip one end through the hole. Tape the end of the pipe cleaner to the inside. Tape the handle flaps to the inside.



- Assemble the box and glue the face to the side of the box opposite to the side with the tail. Now this little piggy is ready to hold your savings!
