LADY LADYBUG!

*This little ladybug has her own
yummy green leaf to sit on!*

Supplies in kit

- 1 ladybug body
- 2 red wings
- 1 precut antennae
- 6 black dot stickers
- 2 white ring stickers for eyes
- 1 smile
- 3 precut paper strips for legs
- 1 large precut green leaf



What you'll need from home

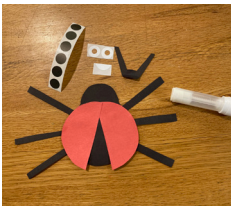
- glue stick or liquid school glue

Directions

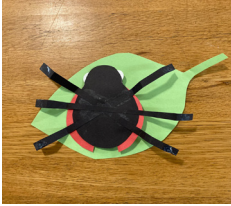
1. Glue the legs to the underside of the ladybug's body in a crisscross fashion.



2. Turn the body over and glue on the wings. Next add glue to the base of the antennae, and attach them to the top of the ladybug's head. Gently fold them so that they stand up. Add the black dots, eyes, and smile.



3. Turn the ladybug over, gently bend the ends of the legs to make feet, and add glue to the bottoms. Turn the ladybug over, and pinch the top of the legs so that they are pointing down. Press the glued feet to the leaf, allowing your Lady Ladybug to stand up.
