# FIREFLY NIGHT-LIGHT!

*Light up a hot summer night with your own little firefly!*

## Supplies in kit

- 1 hollow egg
- 2 pipe cleaner pieces
- paper wings
- 4 mini craft sticks
- 2 white dot stickers
- 2 colored stickers
- 1 piece of green paper
- 1 tea light



## What you'll need from home

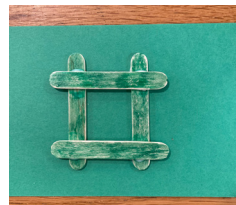
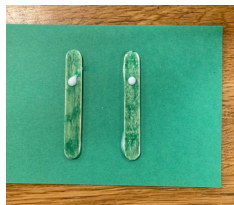
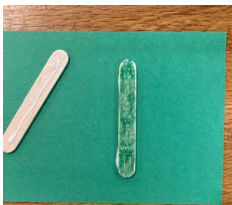
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- sticky tape
- waterproof marker
- color markers

## Directions

1. Color each of the craft sticks in the color of your choice.



2. Glue the craft sticks to the green paper base as pictured. Set aside to dry. This will be the base to hold your firefly.



3. Gently bend one end of each pipe cleaner to make a little

curl. Insert one pipe cleaner into each of the two holes on the shorter side of the plastic egg. Add a little sticky tape to the inside of the egg to hold them in place. Next add the eyes and draw on a happy little smile!



4. Use sticky tape to attach the wings to the egg's larger side.



5. Now it's time to light up our little firefly friend! Turn on the tea light and tuck it into the head of the firefly as pictured. Next clip on the tail end of the egg and watch it glow! Place your firefly on the base to keep it from flying away!
