NESTING TURKEY!

This colorful bird will stay comfortable nesting at your house for the festive fall season!



Supplies in kit

- 1 turkey head and feathers template
- 2 white dot stickers
- 1 prepared brown paper tube
- 1 pre-cut piece of cardstock for nesting platform

What you'll need from home

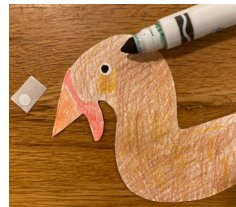
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- colored markers, pencils, or crayons
- scissors

Directions

1. Begin by coloring the turkey head and feathers. Use lots of colors - the fancier the better! Then cut them out.

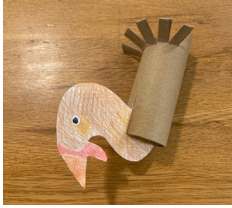


2. Turn the turkey's head over and color the other side. Add a white dot on each side of the turkey head and add a bit of black to each for the eyes.

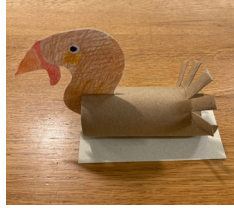


3. Slide the turkey's head into the slit at the front of the tube,

then gently fold up the five precut tabs at the end of the paper tube.



4. Add glue to the paper base, and place the turkey onto it.



5. When it is firmly on the base, it's time to add the feathers. What a colorful bird you have made!
