SPOOKY HALLOWEEN SUN CATCHER!

Add a little mystery to your Halloween decor with this moody silhouette sun catcher!



Supplies in kit

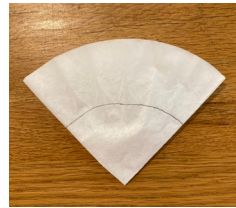
- 1 black paper plate ring
- 3 coffee filters (2 extra for different color combination to choose from)
- 1 string

What you'll need from home

- watercolor paints
- black marker
- hole puncher
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- paper towels

Directions

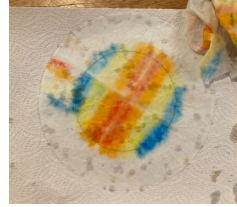
1. Place the paper plate on a flattened coffee filter, and trace the cut out circle on to the filter with a pencil as pictured, then fold the filter in half twice to make a wedge.



2. Using water soluble markers, add your color choices to the folded coffee filter. Make sure to use good moist markers for best results. Feel free to color past the pencil border.



3. Moisten a piece of paper towel, wrap the coffee filter, and press down to help the colors to blend through the layers. Drizzle or spritz more water if needed. Set aside for a few minutes before unwrapping, then gently unfold and place on a sheet of paper towel to dry.



4. When the filter is dry, pencil a spooky silhouette inside the colored circle. Fill it in with black marker.



5. Glue the paper plate on the coffee filter and trim the excess filter. Then punch two holes on the top edge of the paper circle and add the string. Now you have a one of a kind spooky work of art to hang in your window for all to see!
