## 3D APPLE TREE!

*A classic part of October in New England are trips to the apple orchard for crisp fresh apples! Celebrate this noble fruit with this whimsical tree craft.*



### Supplies in kit

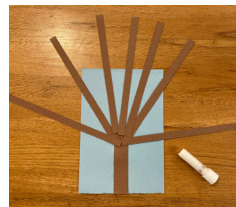
- 1 piece of blue paper
- 7 long brown paper strips
- 2 shorter brown paper strips
- several apples and leaves to fill your branches

### What you'll need from home

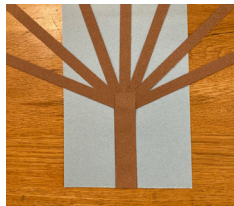
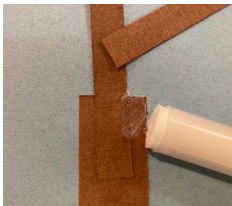
- glue stick or liquid school glue

### Directions

1. Glue the first short strip of paper to the lower section of the blue paper - this is the apple tree trunk. Then glue the long brown strips to the "trunk" as pictured.

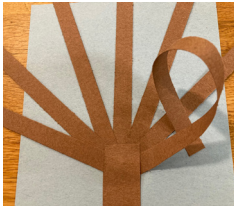


2. Place the other short strip of paper tree trunk over the first.



3. Add a little glue to the tip of a branch, and curl the branch over to make a loopy branch. Do the same with each branch and intertwine them if possible to create a fancy tangle of

branches for your apples.



4. It's time to fill your tree with enough apples to make a big batch of apple pies!
