SNOWY THE OWL!

Snowy Owls live way up in the North Pole. Their fluffy feathers keep them warm in the freezing Arctic wind, but this little Snowy will be very happy to find a perch in your house!

Supplies in kit

- 1 piece of blue construction paper template
- 2 pieces of copy paper
- 2 cupcake wrappers



- 2 feet
- 1 beak
- 1 brown paper "branch"
 - 1 piece of string

What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue
- · color markers, pencils, or crayons
- hole puncher

Directions

 Tear the copy paper into chunky shreds, then glue the shreds in layers on the template. Have fun gluing them every which way!





2. When you have covered the owl's body with feathers, add the branch and the feet.



3. Color the inside bottom of the muffin wrappers with yellow, add a big black dot for the eyes, and glue the eyes and beak to Snowy's head.





4. Finally, punch two holes at the top of the paper, thread in the string, and tie a knot at the top. Now Snowy will be able to perch wherever you choose. Hoot!
