3D SNOWFLAKE!

Get a head start on the season of snow with this fun twirling snowflake!

Supplies in kit


- 6 paper snowflake "branch" templates
- 1 string for hanging

What you'll need from home

- glue stick, liquid school glue, or tape
- scissors

Directions

1. Fold each paper square in half and then in half again.




2. Cut along the printed lines being careful not to cut past the end of the line. Carefully open the square and flatten it.





3. Lay a pencil across the square and gently wrap the center of the cut paper around the pencil and tape or glue it in place.







4. Slide the pencil out and turn the square over. Glue or tape the next two corners together as pictured. Continue flipping and gluing each segment.



5. Finally the segment will look like this. Make six segments.



6. Glue two of the branches at the centers and again at the end point as pictured. Take your time pinching each part firmly together (a stapler might help!). Continue until all segments are together. Thread a string through the top of one segment and enjoy your winter wonderland!
