COZY CARDINAL!

A little wrapping of soft yarn makes this cardinal nice and warm!

Supplies in kit

- red cardinal bird shape with pre-punched hole
- red wing shape
- black and white sticky dots
- black “face mask”
- orange beak
- red yarn for wrapping
- piece of twine for hanging

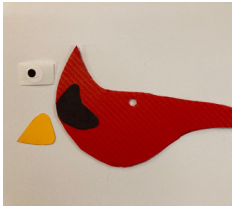


What you'll need from home

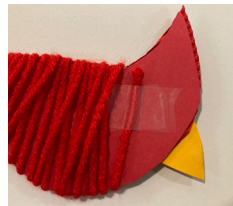
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- sticky tape

Directions

1. Begin by gluing the parts of the bird's face to the body as pictured.



2. Next, turn the bird over, and tape one end of the yarn to the back as pictured. Wrap the yarn around the body of your bird. When you are finished, tape the end to the back as well.



3. Finally, tuck in the wing, and thread the string through the hole. Now your cozy cardinal is ready to fly!
