ROCKET TO THE STARS!

When you color and assemble this little rocket, it will surely be a stand-out as it flies to the stars!

Supplies in kit

- 1 template of rocket
- 1 paper tube
- 1 piece of black paper
- 1 length of yarn
- 2 strips of gold star stickers

What you'll need from home

- glue stick
- sticky tape
- color markers, pencils, or crayons
- scissors
- · hole puncher

Directions

1. Wrap the tube with black paper using glue and tape as pictured.







2. Tuck the edges into the tube.





3. Color and cut out your rocket, glue it to the tube, and add the stars.







4. Finally, punch a hole in each end of the tube. Push the yarn through one end. Let it run down the length of the tube and then thread it out though the other hole. Tie the two ends together and your rocket is ready to blast off!
