MAKE-BELIEVE SNOW GLOBE!

It's always a snow day with this make-believe snow globe!

Supplies in kit

- 1 section of a paper tube
- 1 strip of gold paper
- 1 black paper circle
- 3 snowman sections
- 1 red cap
- 1 white paper dot for a pompom
- 2 cut paper sticks for arms
- 1 strip of white dots

What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue (sticky tape if needed)
- scissors
- black marker, colored pencil, or crayon
- orange marker, colored pencil, or crayon

Directions

1. Glue then wrap the paper tube section with the gold paper. If needed, use sticky tape to help keep it wrapped. Tuck the edge of the paper into the tube as pictured.



2. Cut one slit on each side of the covered tube. These will hold the "globe" upright in place.







3. Now it's time to build the snowman! Glue the 3 white snowman circles in a stack to the black circle as pictured. Add the sticks for arms, the red cap, and pompom. Draw on a face and any other decorations that you like. Finally, add in the white dot snow storm, and fasten the circle to the slits in the paper so your snowman can stand proud!
