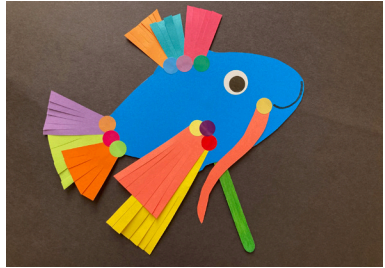


# CRAFT KITS FROM THE PROVIDENCE ATHENÆUM'S CHILDREN'S LIBRARY

### Supplies in kit

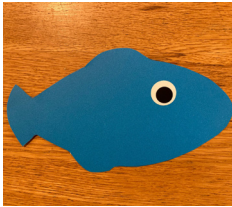
- 1 pre-cut fish form
- 1 bag of upcycled craft paper
- 1 strip of mixed color sticky dots
- 1 each white and black sticky dots
- 1 colored craft stick

### What you'll need from home

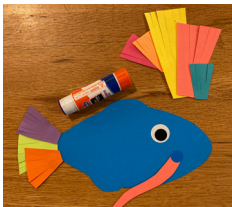
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- sticky tape
- color marker, colored pencil, or crayons to add your own details (optional)

### Directions

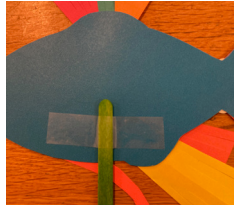
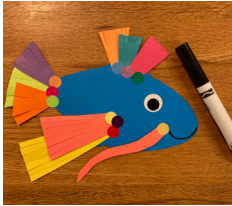
1. Add the white and black sticky dots for the eye.



2. Use the upcycled materials, the colorful sticky dots, and any other elements you have to the fish template, to create a wild one of a kind magic fish.



3. Now it's time to add a smile and a craft stick to make a spectacular swimming puppet!
