RIBBIT THE FROG!

This happy frog is eager to catch a fly or two! Can you help?

Supplies in kit

- 1 template of frog shapes
- 2 white and 2 black dot stickers
- 1 black disc
- 1 pink tongue shape

What you'll need from home

- · glue stick or liquid school glue
- scissors
- stapler
- marker to draw on nostrils

Directions

 Cut out the frog body shapes. Glue one green disc to the black disk, then fold it gently in half and glue on the pink tongue as pictured.







2. Fold the remaining green disc in half and line it up with the black and green discs as pictured. Staple just around the upper edge of the folded black and green disks discs.









3. Now add the arms and legs. Notice the pocket where the discs come together. That is where you will tuck your fingers to help the frog open and close its mouth.



4. Ribbit needs eyes! Fold the bottom edge of the eyes and add the sticker dots. Glue them to the top of Ribbit's mouth.





5. Draw on the two nostrils, and Ribbit is ready (with your help) to catch some tasty flies.
