SWIRL THE SNAIL!

Swirl is a cheerful little snail who really loves color! Can you bring a little color to Swirl's shell?

Supplies in kit

- 1 snail body template
- white and black dot stickers
- 5 colored strips of paper

What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue
- markers to draw on Swirl's smile
- scissors

Directions

1. Begin by cutting out Swirl's body.






2. Add the eyes to the eye "stalks."



3. Add a smile and fold the top part of Swirl, leaving enough of the back to hold the shell.



4. Add glue to the end of the paper strip and paste to the other end to create a circle. Do this with each strip to create five different sized circles that will fit into each other.



5. Now it's time to fit the circles together to form Swirl's shell! Begin with the smallest circle and add glue to the outside part of the circle where it is joined together. Carefully slip it inside the circle that is next in size and press to hold it in place. Repeat with all of the circles in order as pictured. Glue the shell to the body, and Swirl will be a happy little snail indeed!
