UNIDENTIFIED FLYING FRIEND!

Make your own UFF - a flying saucer complete with a fun little alien critter!

Supplies in kit

- 2 paper plates
- mixed sticker dots and stars
- black and white sticky dots
- 1 plastic cup
- 1 piece of folded tin foil
- 1 UFF figure

What you'll need from home

- liquid school glue
- stapler
- color markers, pencils, crayons, or paint

Directions

1. Using your imagination, color in the bottom of the paper plate with the lines drawn to fill in. It's okay to ignore the lines and create other patterns or no patterns! The colored circle stickers along with the stars make it even more jazzy!



2. Using the plastic cup as a guide, trace a circle on top of the decorated paper plate. This will be where the glue will be applied when you add the cup to finish the flying saucer.








3. Carefully unfold the tinfoil and wrap it around the second paper plate. Turn the foil covered plate over, and staple it to the top plate as pictured.



4. Now create your alien friend! Fold the bottom part to help the little UFF sit up in the flying saucer.



5. Glue the UFF to the center of the top of the flying saucer. Then add liquid school around the circle that you drew earlier and place the plastic cup over your alien. When the wet glue dries, the cup will stay in place, and it is off to the stars!
