DANDY LION!

This craft gives us a good excuse to head outside for some fresh air, sunshine, and an epic dandelion hunt! ROARRRRR!

Supplies in kit

- 1 prepared dandy lion template
- 2 black sticky dots



What you'll need from home

- markers, crayons, or colored pencils.
- dandelions or any stemmed flower of your choice (when hunting for flowers, be sure to have an adult helper!)

Directions

1. Begin by coloring lion's face and adding the eyes.







2. Head outdoors and look for dandelions and/or other stemmed flowers to pick. Pull the stems through holes around the lion's face and whatever flowers you choose will become a Dandy Lion's mane! After a while, the flowers will shrivel. When that happens you can go back out find more flowers and make a new mane again and again!
