OLYMPIC GOLD!

When it's an Olympic summer, it's always nice to have a Gold Medal to go with your olive leaf crown!



Supplies in kit

- 1 prepared gold paper disc
- 2 printed templates of Athena and the Olympic torch

What you'll need from home

- markers or colored pencils.
- scissors
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- hole puncher
- ribbon for the medal

Directions

1. Color Athena and the Olympic torch, then cut them out.



2. Glue Athena's picture to the sparkly side, and then glue the torch to the plain gold side.



3. Use a hole puncher to make the hole for your ribbon to pass

through and add the your ribbon as pictured. Now you have a gold medal fit for a true Olympian!
