# OLLY THE OCTOPUS!

*Olly is a super easy craft that's great for painting outdoors!*

## Supplies in kit

- 1 paper tube
- 2 each black and white sticky dots
- 1 strip of 48 white sticky dots



## What you'll need from home

- markers or watercolor paints
- scissors

## Directions

1. Begin by painting Olly. Did you know that octopuses can change colors and patterns on their bodies? How colorful will you make this little octopus? Set it aside to dry.



2. When the painted tube is dry, use the pre-cut notches to cut the tentacles, then add Olly's suction cup stickers. Now he's ready to use his 8 legs to explore the seven seas!
