

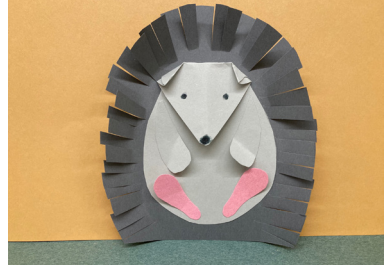

HAPPY HEDGEHOG!

Have fun putting together this happy little hedgehog!

Supplies in kit

- 1 light gray paper hedgehog shape template
- 1 pre-cut dark gray paper half oval shape
- 2 pre cut pink feet and light gray paws

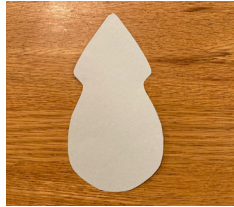
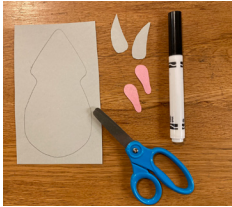


What you'll need from home

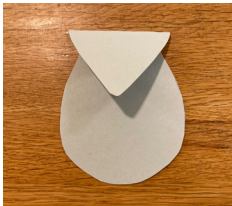
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- scissors
- a marker for the eyes and nose

Directions

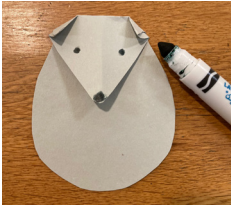
1. Begin by cutting out the hedgehog body shape.



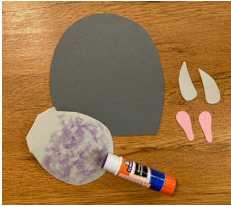
2. Next fold the "head" just below what will be the ears, then fold the ears and gently pinch the snout as pictured.



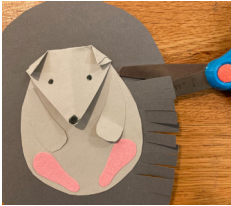
3. Draw the eyes and nose.



4. Now it's time to glue the body to the "back". Next add the two pink feet and paws. Leave a little bit of the ends of the paws and feet without glue so that you can gently lift them as pictured.



5. It's time to make the little hedgehog's frills and quills by snipping around the edges of the dark gray paper. Then slightly bend the "quills" here and there to make a fluffy, ruffly, happy hedgehog!
