THANKSGIVING CROWN!

You will be the star of the family feast with this handsome Turkey Crown!



Supplies in kit

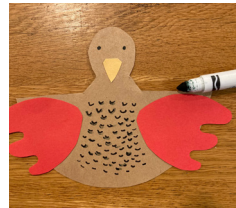
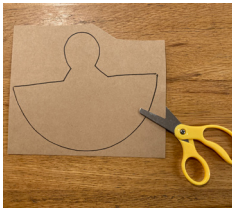
- 2 strips of orange paper for the crown
- 1 turkey template
- 6 different colored feathers
- 2 pre-cut red wings, 1 beak, 1 wattle

What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue
- scissors
- color marker or pencil
- sticky tape or a stapler

Directions

1. Cut out the turkey shape, then draw on the eyes and glue on the wings, beak, and wattle. This is a good time to draw on any details that you might like to add.



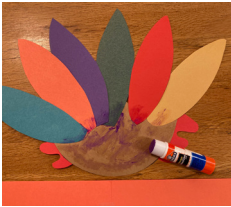
2. Turn the turkey body over, and glue the feathers to the back to form a fan shape.



3. Tape the two orange paper strips together to make one long strip. Measure the paper around your head to fit and tape it together to make the round crown.



4. Gently flatten the crown, and glue the turkey to what will be the front. Your crown is now ready for you to wear!
