A MACARONI PENGUIN PAL!

This little macaroni penguin will love spending the chilly days floating on its own little iceberg at your house!

Supplies in kit

- 2 sections of a paper towel roll (one is larger than the other)
- 2 pre-cut strips of black paper
- 2 pre-cut yellow paper "feathers"
- 2 pre-cut orange feet
- 1 orange beak
- 1 pre-cut white tummy
- 2 each white and black sticker dots
- 1 piece of blue paper
- 1 pre-cut white iceberg

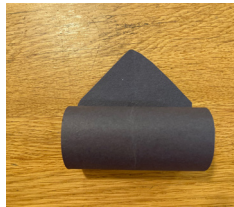


What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue

Directions

1. Add lots of glue to the paper strip with the pointed end, and wrap it around the larger paper tube, leaving some of the pointed end unglued as pictured. This will be the penguin's tail. Tuck the edges of the paper into the tube on each side.



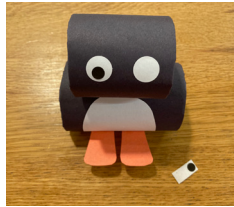
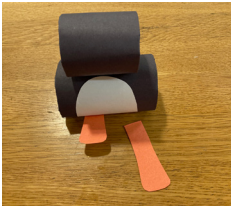
2. Glue the other strip of black paper around the smaller tube, and tuck in the paper edges as you did with the first.



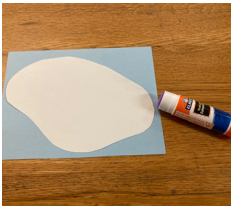
3. Add lots of glue to the top of the larger tube, and center the smaller tube on top. Hold it there until it stays connected to the bottom tube. The penguin's tail on the bottom tube will help it to balance when the "head" attached.



4. Glue the white belly to the front of the bottom tube. Add the feet, eyes, beak, and feathers as pictured.



5. Finish by gluing the white paper iceberg to the blue paper water and the little macaroni penguin on top of the iceberg where it will feel right at home!
