Supplies in kit

- 1 snake template
- 2 each black and white sticky dots
- 1 strip of colored sticky dots
- 1 pre-cut tongue

What you'll need from home

- scissors
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- colored markers, pencils, watercolor paints, or crayons

Directions

1. Using your choice of coloring material, color in the snake template. If you use watercolor paints, try to keep them on the dryer side of wet. Too much water will warp the paper. Watercolors were used below and when dry, crayon was added. Have fun mixing up colors and decorative designs on your snake!



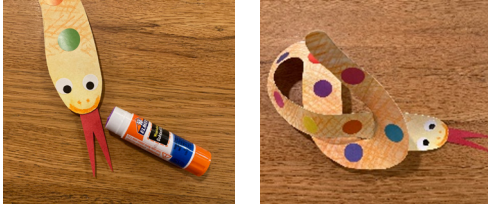
2. Cut out the template and add. If watercolors are used, be sure to let the paper dry before cutting.



3. Add the colored sticker dots and the sticker eyes.



4. Finally attach the tongue as pictured, and tuck Curly's head under the tail to make Curly the Snake curly!
