JOLLY JELLYFISH!

There's something "fishy" in the Craft Kit this month, and it's this jolly jellyfish activity!

Supplies in kit

- prepared paper plate
- 14 colored strings
- tiny sponge paint brush

What you'll need from home

- · watercolor paints, crayons, or color markers
- markers or crayons to draw the eyes and smile
- glue stick or liquid school glue

Directions

 Begin by painting or coloring the paper plate. Coloring both sides is optional.



2. When the paint is dry, glue the top of the paper plate together at the edges.



3. Now it's time to add jellyfish tentacles. Pick up two pieces of the string, holding them together. Fold the pair in half (don't worry if the ends are mismatched) tuck the folded end through the first hole in the paper plate as pictured. Next thread the other end of the string through the loop and



gently pull the strings until they are fully connected to the plate. Repeat until all of the holes have the string attached.







4. Finally add a face to your Jolly Jellyfish and give those tentacles a friendly shake! If you would like to hang your Jolly Jellyfish, punch a hole through the top of the paper plate, and tie with a ribbon or string.
