GO-GO GOLDFISH!

There is something fishy here - this goldfish is wearing a sweater! Use the bright colored yarn to make a woolly fish of your own.

Supplies in kit

- 1 pre-cut and notched (upcycled) cardboard fish
- 1 each black and white dots
- 1 long length of yarn

What you'll need from home

- · sticky tape
- color markers or crayons

Directions

1. Color the white side of the fish as pictured.



2. Next slip one end of the yarn in the first cut notch and tape this end to the back of the fish shape. Begin wrapping the fish by hooking the yarn into the notches until it reaches the head. Keep wrapping the yarn this way and that, in any direction so that it criss-crosses across the whole body of the fish. When you reach the end of the yarn turn the fish over, and tie the end to a strand as pictured.









3. Finally, add the eye stickers and a happy smile, and your little fish is ready to Go-Go!
