A CHEERFUL CHICKEN!

This little chicken loves to rock back and forth. Perhaps she's looking for food!



Supplies in kit

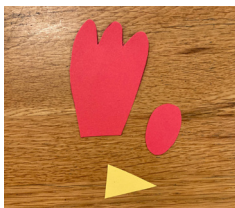
- 1 pre-folded paper plate
- 1 comb and wattle template
- 1 beak
- 1 eye sticker
- 1 each pre-cut wing and tail

What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue
- scissors

Directions

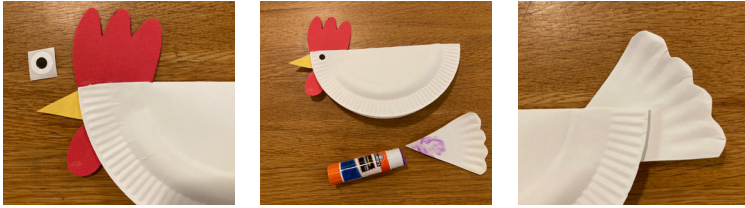
1. Cut out the chicken's comb and wattle. Cut a slit in each side of the paper plate as pictured.



2. Next, slip the comb into the second slit in the plate at an angle and trim off the bit that is sticking out. Add a good amount of glue to the inside edge below the slit in the plate and press the comb in place. Glue the wattle and the beak to the comb. Add more glue to the inside top of the plate and press it together. You may need to hold it in place until the glue dries.



3. Once the paper plate is secure, add the eye. Next, add glue to the “tail feathers” as well as the paper plate and slide the tail in the second slit and pinch it firmly together.



4. Finally, glue on the wing. To balance the little chicken on her tummy gently part the two sides of the paper plate. Tap her tail or beak to make her rock back and forth!
