APRIL SHOWERS!

This little character is well prepared for some serious April puddle jumping!

Supplies in kit

- 1 piece of white cardstock
- 1 template for a green umbrella
- 1 template for red boots
- 1 template for yellow raincoat
- 1 piece of pipe cleaner shaped like an umbrella handle
- 1 each pre-cut silver cloud and puddle



What you'll need from home

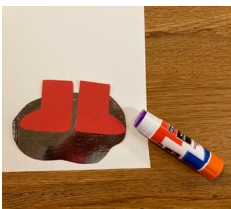
- scissors
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- sticky tape
- watercolor paint

Directions

1. Cut out the shapes from the templates.



2. Glue the "puddle" to the bottom of the white paper and glue the boots on top as pictured. Then glue the raincoat over the boots.



3. Position the pipe cleaner handle across the raincoat and tape it down as pictured. Next glue the umbrella over the pipe cleaner, making sure that a little bit of the pipe cleaner sticks out of the top.



4. Glue the silver cloud to the top of the paper.



5. Using a damp finger and watercolors, fingerprint little raindrops all over the paper to make a lovely April shower!
