A HUNGRY CATERPILLAR!

This friendly (and a little hungry) caterpillar craft will be a cheerful daily reminder of our VERY FAVORITE classic picture book!

Supplies in kit

- 6 strips of green paper
- 1 strip of red paper
- 2 round yellow stickers
- 2 black antennae
- 1 green leaf

What you'll need from home


- glue stick or liquid school glue
- sticky tape
- marker to draw on the eye

Directions

 Begin by gluing or taping each of the strips of green paper into circles as close to the same size as possible. Next, glue the red strip into a circle. Pinch it gently on two sides to make it an oval shape as pictured.



2. Now it's time to draw the nose and add pupils to the yellow eye dots with your marker! Next glue the antennae to the back of the caterpillar's red head.







3. Using sticky tape, join the green circles together as pictured and tape the head to the end.



4. Finally, tape the end of the caterpillar to the leaf and then gently "scrunch" the body to fit on the leaf and add tape to hold it in place. This little caterpillar will now happily munch its yummy green leaf all day!
