A SAILBOAT CRAFT!

in Rhode Island without sailboats.
Have fun fashioning your own
jaunty sea vessel!*

Supplies in kit

- 1 paper towel section with pre-cut slit
- 2 pre-cut paper plate halves
- 1 wooden craft stick
- 1 strip of colored stickers
- 1 strip of star stickers
- 1 strip of white "doughnut" stickers
- 1 paper sail
- 1 pirate flag




What you'll need from home

- glue stick or liquid school glue
- watercolor paints or markers
- stapler

Directions


1. Pinch the two sides of the paper plate together and staple the side edges, leaving the bottom of the boat open.



2. Using paint or markers, color the boat. Let dry if needed.



3. Glue all over the inside of the paper sail, making sure to put glue along the line where it's folded, and press the craft stick into the fold. Press the two sides of the sail together.



4. It's time to decorate the flag and the boat with stickers!



5. Slip the craft stick into the slit in the paper towel tube, then tuck it securely into the boat to help your craft stand up. Now, you're ready to sail the seas of your imagination!
