# A SALTY SAILOR SPOON PAL!

Ahoy there! Look what you can make with a little wooden spoon, some paper, a pipe cleaner and, markers: a jolly little sailor to sail your boat!

#### Supplies in kit

- 1 T-shirt template
- 1 hat template
- 1 small wooden spoon
- 1 pipe cleaner

#### What you'll need from home

- colored pencils or markers
- glue stick or liquid school glue
- scissors

### Directions

1. Color and cut out the T-shirt and hat. Note: there is a small cut in the T-shirt's neck circle for the spoon to slip into.



2. Draw Salty's face on your wooden spoon using markers or colored pencils.





3. Slip the spoon handle gently into the slit in the T-shirt's neck as pictured.



4. Fold up the front of the T-shirt, then wrap the pipe cleaner around the spoon handle a couple of times to make Salty's arms.



5. Finally, color the spoon handle, add glue to the edges of the T-shirt, and pinch the front and back together. Now your Salty little sailor is ready to set sail!
